Which are the benefits of peer to peer tutoring?

Increase in confidence for both the students involved

The assisting student gains more confidence

The struggling student gets more time to learn



This strategy aids in giving weaker students individualised attention

It improves social and interpersonal skills

Empathy and compassion among learners



Peer turoring as means to inclusion

Some students with disabilities respond better to peers than adults. Students with disabilities get more individual attention than one teacher can provide on their own.
